Board Member Job Description

The board of directors is entrusted with the governance and oversight of this organization. The board's overarching job is to ensure that we as a nonprofit fulfill our mission and continue to meet community needs in a way that honors the public trust.

Specifically, the board will:

- Hire, support, and evaluate the performance of the organization's executive director or senior staff person;
- Monitor the organization's financial health;
- Participate in and approve long-range planning for the organization;
- Establish overarching policies for the organization;
- Help secure funding for the organization;
- Evaluate the effectiveness of the organization in fulfilling its mission and meeting community needs;
- Ensure that the organization acts in accordance with its articles of incorporation and bylaws, as well as applicable laws;
- Provide general oversight for the organization;
- Represent the organization within the broader community; and
- Provide for the regular recruitment and orientation of new board members.

Individual board members are expected to:

- Know and be committed to the organization's mission;
- Actively participate in regularly scheduled meetings;
- Participate in one or more committees of the board;
- Attend board retreats, planning meetings, workshops, and other board development activities;
- Make an annual personal or professional financial contribution; and
- Bring personal and professional expertise to support the mission of the organization.

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
