

Dear UM Students,

Several services will be unavailable during a planned outage that will run from **Friday, September 29 to Tuesday, October 3, 2023**. This is due to the 18-month campus-wide project to improve UM's tech infrastructure (also known as the Banner Cloud Migration).

Unavailable services provided by the Office of the Registrar during this time include (but are not limited to):

- Registration Edits and Course Add/Change/Drop requests
- Transcript ordering
- Enrollment verifications
- Student record updates (name changes, chosen name updates, etc.)
- All services in CyberBear, including access to your schedule
- Processing major changes, distance changes, or graduation applications
- Degree Works

These services will also not be available in-person. Please plan to take care of any business related to these services before or after the outage.
